Spring Clean Up is just around the corner. Can you please support us as your service provider and remember to remind your residents of the following:

Our goal is to complete clean up as quickly and efficiently as possible and to do this, we hire extra staff every year.

Spring clean up is a general tidying of your home. It is not completing a renovation project at the expense of the community.

All items for cleanup week must be put out no later than Monday morning of your designated week, any waste put out to the road side after this date will be the property owners responsibility.

Under no circumstances will any area be revisited after the pickup is completed. We will be notifying you each day when we stop so you will know what portion of your community has been done. We receive numerous calls every year regarding this issue. We do not skip any households. We double check the street before we move on and the only time items are left behind is if the homeowner has not followed the guidelines. It is very challenging on our part when we get calls stating that we have missed households and are asked repeatedly to go back.

All items must be placed near the curbside/roadside.

Metal items must be separated from all other items. We use a separate truck just for metals.

Please see the attached list of accepted / unaccepted items to assist residents

Items for pickup **must be** bagged, boxed or bound as large piles of small debris will **not be** collected unless it's contained. This has been a problem in the past years with residents dumping unbagged items down at the bottom of the driveway and expecting us a collector to hand pick up waste. Our team does not hand pick or shovel up loose waste.

Items for pickup must still follow Sort It Western guidelines and either be in clear bags for waste and blue bags for recyclables.

Our team takes pride in a job well done and works very hard to ensure your satisfaction. We appreciate your support in getting the word out to all residents to ensure a smooth community clean up for everyone. Thank you in advance for being a part of our team!

Spring Clean Up 2019

Spring Clean-Up is the special collection of general household items that are too bulky for normal collection. During this period, residents are requested to make a special effort to clean up their properties.

Residents are asked to have all items out to the curb by Monday morning at 8:00am. Once an area has been completed, it will **not be** collected again. All items must be placed near the curbside / roadside.

Metal items must be separated from all other items.

Items for pickup **must** be bagged, boxed or bound (no more than 40lbs) as large piles of small debris will not be collected unless it is contained.

Acceptable

- Cardboard: Flattened & Bound
- Electrical Wire: Coiled & Bound
- Light Fixtures, Fans: Floor & Ceiling
- Household Appliances: Stove, Washer, Dryer, Microwave, Hot Water Tank
- Fencing Wire: Bound
- Electronics: TV's, Computer Monitors & Towers, Video Gaming Systems, Stereos
- Lawn Mowers, Generators and Power Saws: MUST be drained of oil and gas
- Bicycles and Tricycles
- Tires: ATV/UTV & Bicycle
- Children's Larger Toys & Items
- Household Furniture: Sofas, Chairs, Dressers, Desk, Kitchen Table & Chairs, Mattress & box spring
- Lawn Furniture
- BBQ's – no tanks
- Carpet / Linoleum – Rolled & Bound
- Paint Cans – Lids Off & Completely Dry
- Doors, Windows, Patio Doors – Glass must be taped
- Tiles – Boxed & Bound
- Countertops – Must be no longer than 4 foot sections
- Vehicle Parts under 50 lbs
- Fiberglass Insulation MUST be bagged & sealed
- Shelving / Cupboards – Must be broken down and bound
- Fridges / Freezers

Unacceptable

- Compostable Materials: Grass, Weeds, Branches, Leaves, Etc.
- Wood: Pallets, Lumber, Decks, Plywood
- Car Parts exceeding 50 lbs including axles, door, rear ends, gas or diesel tanks, bonnets, truck liners, truck caps, ATV frames, etc.
- Renovation Material including drywall, roof shingles, bricks, cement or concrete.
- Fire Extinguishers, Welding Tanks, Air Tank or any other Pressurized Tank.
- Propane Tanks
- Vehicle Batteries
- Vehicle Tires
- Gas Cans
- Oil Tanks or Furnaces
- Medical Waste
- Liquid Waste
- Hazardous Materials: Used Oil, Tar Buckets, Paint Cans with Paint, Poisons, Chemicals, Solvents, Explosive Material, Toxic Material
