A Wind Turbine committee formed of 18 people of the Port au Port region came together to discuss the concerns, the issues and the comments made by all community members. As promised by the company, World Energy GH2, ten committee members went to visit the Grand Renewable Wind Farm in Hamilton, Ontario to experience firsthand what it was like to be near a wind farm. A lot of questions were answered in regards to some of the issues that were raised, however some questions still remain. As a regional group, our goal is to ensure that we do our very best to address all issues and concerns and to answer everyone's questions to the best of our ability.

What we want you to know :

- We have asked for an extension of the project and we will know on August 5th if we have been successful.
- If this project is approved, we will try to ensure that the location of the wind turbines meet the approval of all communities.
- We will encourage the Government to do a detailed environmental assessment and to conduct a noise study before a shovel goes into the ground.
- It is important to remember that the Minister's decision is the first decision but not the final decision.
- The public can be reassured that this committee will work with the company, if given approval, to ensure that we will maximize the benefits and minimize the negative environmental impacts on the Port au Port region.
