## *Student Summer Projects*



## Student Summer Projects

1. Provide that funding is available from the Department of Human Resources and Skills Development Canada, the Town of Port au Port East will submit annually applications to hire students for Summer Projects as follows:
  - i. Two (2) post – secondary students will be hired for the Maria Regina Parish Council. These positions, if granted, will be for 8 weeks duration at 35 hours per week – minimum wage. (Tourist Information Centre Assistant)
  - ii. Two (2) post – secondary students will be hired for the Twilight Senior’s 50+ Club. These positions, if granted, will be for 8 weeks duration at 35 hours per week – minimum wage (Senior’s Helpers)
  - iii. One (1) Lever I, II, or III student. This position will be 5 or 6 weeks duration at 20 hours per week – minimum wage (Tourist Information Centre Assistant)

### **Senior’s Helpers**

2. Senior’s Helpers will be required to wear Steel Nosed Boots when doing any outside work.

### **Tourist Information Centre Assistances**

3. Funding for gas will be provided by the Town to take student workers on a tour of the peninsula so that they may become familiar with the area. This will take place during the first week of work.
